Applicants are reminded that:

- Applications must be made on the Faculty's generic [examination entry form](#) which is available directly from the Faculty office or can be downloaded from the Faculty's website www.facocmed.ac.uk. It must be accompanied by four copies of the portfolio. The Faculty must receive the original signed form and **under no circumstances will a photocopied or faxed form be accepted.**
- Cheques should be made payable to: Faculty of Occupational Medicine, and should be attached to the application form. All payments should be in pounds sterling from a UK bank, net of all bank charges.
- It is the responsibility of applicants to ensure that all documentation (including fees, even if an employer is paying) reaches the Faculty office by the closing date. The Faculty recommends that mailed applications are sent by a minimum of 'Recorded Delivery'. Entries posted less than five working days before the closing date should be sent by 'Special Delivery'. Applications which arrive after the closing date CANNOT BE ACCEPTED.
